In the Spring and Summer, you might see trees with blossom.

In the Summer and Autumn some of trees will grow berries and nuts and their leaves will change colour before falling to the ground.

In the Winter some of the trees may have bare branches before growing new leaves in the Spring and some of the plants might die away before growing again in Springtime.

You could keep a diary and follow the lifecycle of some of these trees and plants throughout the seasons.
